New Car Limited Warranty

This warranty is given to the owner of any 1987 Acura automobile distributed by American Honda through the Acura Automobile Division, and sold by an authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States.

Time and Mileage Period

This warranty begins on the date the car is sold to the first retail purchaser, or the date it is first used as a demonstrator, lease or company car, whichever comes first. The car is covered for 36 months or 36,000 miles, whichever comes first.

Warranty Coverage

Acura will repair or replace, at its option, any factory-installed part that is defective in material or workmanship under normal use. Normal use excludes any use the Owner's Manual states is not recommended. Warranty repairs will be made free of charge for parts and labor, except for the battery, which will be adjusted on a pro rata basis as described on page 14. Any repaired or replaced parts are covered only for the remainder of this warranty. All parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Acura.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- Emission control systems (refer to the Emission Control Systems Warranty on page 6, and the Emission Controls Performance Warranty on page 7).
- Tires (refer to the tire manufacturer's warranty that came with the car). If you have any problems with your tires, ask your Acura dealer for assistance.
- Parts that fail due to lack of required maintenance, use of non-equivalent parts or racing.
- Normal wear or deterioration of any part.
- Cleaning and polishing.
- Lubrication, unless part of a warranty repair.
- Air conditioner refrigerant charge after the first 90 days, unless part of a warranty repair.
- Glass breakage and/or scratches that are not due to a defect in material or workmanship.
- Appearance items that are not due to a defect in material or workmanship.
- Any car registered or normally driven outside of the United States.

- The replacement of expendable maintenance items when the replacement is not due to a defect in material or workmanship (such as spark plugs, filters, worn wiper blades, worn brakes and worn clutches).
- Any car with an odometer that has been altered, or an odometer on which the actual mileage cannot be determined.
- Adjustments, unless part of a warranty repair. (Brake and clutch adjustments are covered for 12 months.)
- Accessories (refer to the Accessory Limited Warranty on page 12).
- Wheel balancing and wheel alignment beyond 12 months of use.

To Get Warranty Service

You must take your car, along with proof of purchase date, to any authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States during normal service hours. If the car is not drivable because of a defect covered by this warranty, call the nearest authorized Acura automobile dealer for towing assistance. You will not have to pay for towing if the defect is covered by this warranty.

If you cannot get warranty service, or you are dissatisfied with the service or with a warranty decision, refer to the Customer Satisfaction section on page 2.

Your Responsibility

You must have the required maintenance done at the proper intervals, and keep the receipts as proof.

This Warranty is Subject to the Following Limitations and Disclaimers

Acura disclaims any responsibility for loss of time or use of the parts or vehicle in which the parts are installed, transportation or any other incidental or consequential damage. Any implied warranties, including the implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are limited to the duration of this written warranty.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Emission Control Systems Warranty

This warranty is in addition to the Acura New Car Limited Warranty.

Time and Mileage Period

This warranty begins on the date the car is delivered to the first retail purchaser, or the date it is first used as a demonstrator, lease or company car, whichever comes first, and continues for 5 years or 50,000 miles, whichever comes first.

Warranty Coverage

Acura warrants to the owner of any 1987 Acura that the automobile was designed, built and equipped to conform at the time of sale with all U.S. emission standards applicable at the time of manufacture, and that it is free from defects in material and workmanship which would cause it not to meet those standards. Failures caused solely by abuse or lack of proper maintenance are not covered by this warranty.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- Failures or malfunctions resulting from misuse, alteration, accident, use of leaded gasoline or lack of proper maintenance as specified in the Owner's Manual. As proof of proper maintenance, you must have receipts showing that all scheduled maintenance has been done. These receipts should remain with the car if it is sold. Claims for repair or adjustment necessary solely because of defects in material or workmanship will not be denied because the car or engine was not properly maintained or used.
- Replacement of expendable maintenance items such as spark plugs, wires, filters, hoses, belts, coolant and lubricants.
- Loss of time or use of the car, or, to the extent permitted by law or regulation, any other consequential damages.
- Any car with an odometer that has been altered, or an odometer on which the actual mileage cannot be determined.
- Any car registered or normally driven outside of the United States.

Emission Controls Performance Warranty

Time and Mileage Period

This warranty begins on the date the car is delivered to the first retail purchaser, or the date it is first used as a demonstrator, lease or company car, whichever comes first, and continues for 5 years or 50,000 miles, whichever comes first.

Warranty Coverage

Acura warrants to the owner of any 1987 Acura automobile that:

- if your car is maintained and used according to the instructions for its care and use in the 1987 Owner's Manual, and
- it fails an EPA-approved emission test at any time during 5 years or 50,000 miles, whichever comes first, and
- such a failure could result in your being penalized or sanctioned (including denial of the right to use your car under local, state or federal law),

then Acura will, at no cost to you,

- during the first 3 years or 36,000 miles, whichever comes first, make all adjustments, repairs and replacements necessary to ensure your car's compliance with Environmental Protection Agency emission standards, and its continued compliance for the remainder of the warranty period (if properly maintained and used), and
- during the remainder of the warranty period, adjust, repair or replace those parts that were installed for the sole or primary purpose of reducing emissions (and that were not in general use before model year 1985). The parts are listed on pages 10 and 11.

To Get Warranty Service

An EPA-approved Emission Short Test may be made on your car as part of a state inspection and maintenance program. If your car fails the test, and you are faced with a possible penalty or sanction of any kind, take your car to your authorized Acura automobile dealer. Take along a copy of the Short Test report, as evidence of the failure, and your maintenance records.

Your authorized Acura automobile dealer is required to either validate or deny your claim for adjustment, repair or replacement of any parts listed on pages 10 and 11, (1) within 30 days from the time you bring the car to the dealer's facility, or (2) within the time required by local, state or federal law for the car to be repaired without incurring further penalty, whichever is shorter. Exceptions

are when you, the owner, request a delay, or a delay is caused by circumstances beyond the control of Acura or the authorized dealer.

If an authorized Acura automobile dealer cannot repair your car or process your claim within a reasonable time, contact the Acura Customer Service office for assistance. Look in your Owner's Manual for the address and phone number.

If your claim is denied, Acura will explain to you why, in writing. Failure to do so within the required time limit makes Acura liable for correcting, without charge to you, whatever caused the EPA-approved emission test failure.

If, after your claim has been correctly processed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer, you believe you did not receive the warranty coverage described in this warranty, you may write directly to:

Your Responsibility for Maintenance

This warranty assumes you will maintain your 1987 Acura automobile according to the Maintenance Schedule in the Owner's Manual. The schedule is designed to keep your emission control systems functioning properly by maintaining your car's total operating performance. Any lack in total performance may affect the quality of your engine's emissions.

Maintenance, replacement or repair of emission control devices and systems may be done by any automotive repair establishment or individual using parts that are certified to EPA standards. This includes temporary emergency repairs to correct a problem that could be a safety hazard. However, repairs covered by this warranty (except for those temporary emergency repairs) must be made at an authorized Acura automobile dealership, except as provided otherwise by state or local law.

If your car fails the Emission Short Test, and you make a claim to have it brought into compliance with EPA standards, your authorized Acura automobile dealer may ask you for evidence that

you have properly maintained and used the car. Such evidence may consist of:

- A maintenance log book, dated and signed by a person who regularly services automobiles, that includes the odometer mileage when the car was serviced.
- Receipts that prove the required maintenance was done, dated and signed by a person who regularly services automobiles.
- A statement that you, the owner, did the required work. The statement must be accompanied by receipts for certified replacement parts and include the mileage when the work was done. (You could be asked to demonstrate that you are able to do the work properly.)

An authorized Acura automobile dealer's decision that the use of the car has been other than normal is reason for denial of your claim under this warranty. (For a description of normal usage, refer to next page.)

Any claim you make for adjustment, repair or replacement necessary to bring your car into compliance with EPA emission standards may be denied if:

- You have not followed the Maintenance Schedule in your Owner's Manual.
- The maintenance has been done incorrectly.
- A part that the Maintenance Schedule requires to be checked at stated intervals is not checked, and not checking it causes the failure of another emission controls part.

However, claims for repair or adjustment necessary solely because of defects in material or workmanship will not be denied because the car or engine was not properly maintained or used.

NOTE: Receipts for maintenance should be transferred with the car to each subsequent owner.

Your Responsibility for Using Appropriate Replacement Parts

Acura recommends only the use of parts supplied by Acura or equivalent parts which are certified by their manufacturer to meet EPA standards. The use of uncertified replacement parts not equivalent in quality or design to parts supplied by Acura may impair the effectiveness of your car's emission control systems. If an uncertified replacement part is used in the maintenance and

repair of your car, and an authorized Acorn automobile dealer determines it is defective or not equivalent to the original part, your claim for repair to bring your car into compliance with EPA standards may be denied. If, however, the uncertified part is not related to the reason your car fails to meet the standards, your claim will not be denied.

Your Responsibility for Normal Vehicle Use

Your Owner's Manual (which includes specific recommendations against using your car in certain ways) was written with the assumption that you will use your car only in ways for which it was designed.

- To carry passengers and cargo within the load limits shown on the label on the door jamb.
- To be driven on reasonable road surfaces within legal speed limits.
- To generally be driven daily over a distance of several miles.
- To be run on unleaded gasoline of 87 Research Octane Number or higher (Anti-knock Index of 86 or higher as calculated using the Cost of Living Council's formula).
- To be properly maintained according to the Maintenance Schedule in the Owner's Manual.

Accessory Limited Warranty

This warranty is given to the owner of any Acura automobile accessory (except Mugen parts) distributed by American Honda through the Acura Automobile Division, and sold by an authorized Acura automobile dealer.

Time and Mileage Period

For accessories installed prior to retail sale, this warranty begins on the date the car is sold to the first retail purchaser, or the date it is first used as a demonstrator, lease or company car, whichever comes first. The air conditioner and audio system (excluding cassette tape drive mechanism) are covered for the duration of the New Car Limited Warranty: 36 months or 36,000 miles, whichever comes first. The cassette tape drive mechanism and all other dealer-installed accessories are covered for 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever comes first.

For accessories installed after retail sale, this warranty begins on the date the accessory is installed by or purchased from an authorized Acura automobile dealer. Air conditioners and audio systems (excluding cassette tape drive mechanisms) are warranted for the remainder of the New Car Limited Warranty or a minimum of 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever comes first. Accessories other than air conditioners and audio systems are covered for 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever comes first.

All repaired or replaced parts are covered only for the duration of the applicable warranty period described above.

Warranty Coverage

Acura will repair or replace, at its option, any accessory that is defective in material or workmanship under normal use. The accessory must have been purchased from an authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States and installed in an Acura automobile for which it was designed. If the accessory was installed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer, it will be repaired or replaced without charge for parts and labor. If installed by anyone else, it will be repaired or replaced without charge for the parts, but labor charges will be your responsibility. All parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Acura.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- Accessories installed in any car registered or normally driven outside of the United States.
- Normal wear or deterioration of any accessory.

- Accessories installed in a car with an odometer that has been altered, or an odometer on which the actual mileage cannot be determined.
- Air conditioner refrigerant charge after the first 90 days, unless part of a warranty repair.
- Accessories used in applications for which they were not designed, or accessories that were improperly installed.
- Any accessory without proof of purchase date and car mileage at time of installation.

To Get Warranty Service

You must take your car, along with proof of accessory purchase date and car mileage at installation, to any authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States during normal service hours. If the car is not driveable because of a defect covered by this warranty, call the nearest authorized Acura automobile dealer for towing assistance. You will not have to pay for towing if the defect is covered by this warranty.

If you cannot get warranty service, or you are dissatisfied with the service or with a warranty decision, refer to the Customer Satisfaction section on page 2.

This Warranty is Subject to the Following Limitations and Disclaimers

Acura disclaims any responsibility for loss of time or use of the parts or vehicle in which the parts are installed, transportation or any other incidental or consequential damage. Any implied warranties, including the implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are limited to the duration of this written warranty.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Battery Adjustment

If an original battery or a replacement battery provided by Acura fails during its first 36 months in service, it will be adjusted by an authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States.

Original Battery

During the first 24 months from the date the New Car Limited Warranty begins, a defective original battery will be replaced free of charge. If the battery fails after the first 24 months, but before the end of the 36-month New Car Limited Warranty period, you will be given 50% credit toward the purchase of a new battery. No cash reimbursement will be made. Any service or installation charge will be at your expense, except during the 24-month free-of-charge replacement period.

Replacement Battery

During its first 6 months in service, a defective replacement battery will be replaced free of charge. If the replacement battery fails after the first 6 months, you will be given credit toward the purchase of a new battery, figured at 1/35 of the current suggested retail price for each month remaining in the 30-month period. No cash reimbursement will be made. Any service or installation charge will be at your expense, except during the 6-month free-of-charge replacement period for replacement batteries installed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer.

Replacement Muffler Limited Lifetime Warranty

Warranty Coverage

Acura Automobile Replacement Mufflers are warranted against defects in material and workmanship for as long as the original purchaser of the replacement muffler owns the vehicle on which the muffler is installed.

If, during this period, the muffler should fail as a result of defects, it will be exchanged without charge upon presentation of proof of purchase. If originally installed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer, the labor for removal and replacement will also be covered by this warranty.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- Labor for removal and replacement of a defective replacement muffler sold, but not installed, by an authorized Acura automobile dealer. In such instances, the defective replacement muffler only will be exchanged without charge.
- Failure resulting from accidental damage, abuse or alteration.
- All exhaust system pipes, hangers, clamps, gaskets or other mounting hardware, and mufflers supplied as original vehicle equipment.
- Additional labor and/or exhaust system parts which are damaged during the performance of warranty repairs under the terms of this warranty.

To Get Warranty Service

At the time of purchase, your authorized Acura automobile dealer will provide you with a sales invoice or service repair order and a written warranty covering the replacement. These documents together will be considered proof of purchase under the terms of this warranty.

To get a replacement under warranty, take your muffler or the car on which it is installed, and proof of purchase to any authorized Acura automobile dealer during normal service hours.

If you cannot get warranty service or you are dissatisfied with the service or with a warranty decision, refer to the Customer Satisfaction section on page 2.

This Warranty is Subject to the Following Limitations and Disclaimers

Acura disclaims any responsibility for loss of time or use of the parts or vehicle in which the parts are installed, transportation or any other incidental or consequential damage. Any implied warranties, including the implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are limited to the duration of this written warranty.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Replacement Parts Limited Warranty

This warranty is given to the owner of any Acura automobile replacement part distributed by American Honda through the Acura Automobile Division, and sold by an authorized Acura automobile dealer.

Time and Mileage Limits

Parts supplied by Acura and purchased from and installed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer are covered for 6 months or 6,000 miles, whichever comes first, from the date installed. Parts supplied by Acura and purchased from but not installed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer are covered for 6 months from the date of purchase.

Warranty Coverage

Acura will repair or replace, at its option, any part covered under this warranty that is defective in material or workmanship under normal use. Parts that were sold and installed by an authorized Acura automobile dealer will be repaired or replaced without charge for parts or labor; if installed by anyone else, they will be repaired or replaced without charge for the parts, but labor charges will be your responsibility. Replacement batteries will be adjusted on a pro rata basis (see page 14). All parts supplied under this warranty will be supplied by Acura, and all parts replaced become the property of Acura.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- Parts installed in vehicles for racing or competition.
- Parts for which proof of purchase date, installation date and vehicle mileage at time of installation are not presented.
- Parts considered normal maintenance items, unless they are defective in material or workmanship.
- Parts replaced under the New Car Limited Warranty, or parts covered under other warranties.
- Normal wear or deterioration of any part.
- Parts installed in a car with an odometer that has been altered, or an odometer on which the actual mileage cannot be determined.

To Get Warranty Service

The defective part, or the car if it is installed in, must be returned by the purchaser to an authorized Acura automobile dealer during normal service hours. You must provide a receipt that shows proof of purchase as well as the installation date and the mileage at the time of installation, if the installation was done by an authorized Acura automobile dealer. If the car is not drivable because of a defect covered by this warranty, call the nearest authorized Acura automobile dealer for towing assistance. You will not have to pay for towing if the defect is covered by this warranty.

If you cannot get warranty service or you are dissatisfied with the service or with a warranty decision, refer to the Customer Satisfaction section on page 2.

This Warranty is Subject to the Following Limitations and Disclaimers

Acura disclaims any responsibility for loss of time or use of the parts or vehicle in which the parts are installed, transportation or any other incidental or consequential damage. Any implied warranties, including the implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are limited to the duration of this written warranty.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Rust Perforation Limited Warranty

This warranty is given to the owner of any 1997 Acura automobile distributed by American Honda through the Acura Automobile Division, and sold by an authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States. Only the owner of the car is entitled to coverage and reimbursement under this warranty; this right cannot be transferred to anyone else (such as an insurance company).

Time and Mileage Period

This warranty begins on the same date as the New Car Limited Warranty, and continues for 36 months, with no mileage limit. Any parts repaired or replaced under this warranty are covered only for the remainder of this warranty.

Warranty Coverage

Acura will repair or replace, at its option, any original body panels, including those repaired or replaced under this warranty, that are rusted completely through from the inside out (perforated by corrosion). Rust, without perforation, but caused by a defect in material or workmanship, is covered under the New Car Limited Warranty. The owner will not be charged for material and labor. All parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Acura.

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

- Rusting of the outside of the underbody (floor pan) or any other part of the car except body panels.
- Rusting of body panels that were replaced, repaired or refinished after the car was first sold at retail, other than panels replaced under this warranty.
- Body panel rust caused by abuse or lack of maintenance.
- Rust where paint has been damaged by normal road hazards such as stones and debris.
- Rust caused by a body panel being submerged in water, sand or mud, or exposed to corrosive gas or industrial fallout.
- Paint matching. Acura reserves the right to decide whether painting the repaired or replaced panel to match the original finish is practicable. Acura will not, under any circumstances, pay for painting the entire car solely for paint color matching.

To Get Warranty Service

You must take your car, along with proof of purchase, to any authorized Acura automobile dealer in the United States during normal service hours.

If you cannot get warranty service, or you are dissatisfied with the service or with a warranty decision, refer to the Customer Satisfaction section on page 2.

Your Responsibility
